

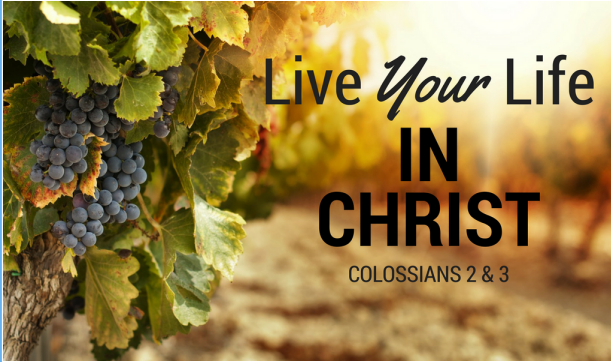

Reflecting on Colossians 2-3, N.T. Wright remarks, "The old taboos put the wild animals of lust and hatred (see 3:5, 8) into cages: there they remain, alive and dangerous, a constant threat to their captors. Paul's solution is more drastic: the animals are to be killed (3:5). The old method of holiness attacked symptoms: the true method goes for the root."
