PRAYER MATTERS

Jenn Taylor is concluding her time as our Kids' Ministry Coordinator and will be flying to Costa Rica on January 2nd to begin language school in preparation for her future as a missionary in Chile. First of all we pray thanksgiving as Jenn is now 98% funded. We also pray for smooth transition as there are still many hurdles to overcome. In order to receive permission to leave, Jenn needs to receive 7 different clearances from 7 different people within ABWE and her sending church. She still needs to receive medical clearance, financial clearance (which she won't get until she is 100% funded), clearance from her Regional Director, from the Canadian office and finally, from the Pre-field Director. Lots of these are wrapped up in each other and we can be praying that by the middle of December she will have received all of them so that she can spend her last couple of weeks in Canada just resting and being with family.
