EVERYDAY MISSION

To be a Christian is to be a participant in God's everyday mission in the world. We say "everyday" mission to emphasize that this isn't about a trip somewhere else for a week or two, but about an everyday life wherever God has us. As someone wise has said, mission is about "ordinary Christians doing ordinary things with gospel intentionality". This month our teaching will explore a few trajectories of this everyday mission and gospel intentionality.

This Sunday's message is brought to us by Daniel McDougall:

On this final Sunday in the Christmas season (Epiphany—'God Made Manifest' Sunday), we get a final 'kick at the can' about the events surrounding Jesus' first arrival, before we proceed with an adult Jesus and the events throughout the rest of his life—and ours.

One of the striking things in the Advent story is the stark difference between those who 'received' the Good News and those who really 'got' it. Today we'll encounter **four very different responses to the arrival of Jesus** and just perhaps we'll see ourselves echoing their responses. What does it mean to really say 'yes' to Jesus? What are the signs of balking against his inconvenient presence? What might happen in our relationships, allegiances, expectations, hopes and even our finances? Let's explore together . . . I think you'll be encouraged!

Daniel and Sandi McDougall joyfully work to introduce Christ and to mentor His love within three distinct sets of people at UVic who come to Canada from all corners of the globe: international students, graduate students, and visiting professors & researchers. Their focus is two-fold: befriending the newcomer (especially through food) and Bible Exploration. Students meet Jesus, unpack issues that help dismantle their barriers to faith, and encounter the God who loves them and has a place of significance for them. Daniel has also recently served as transitional pastor in three local congregations in Victoria (Oaklands Chapel, Emmanuel Baptist & Parkdale Evangelical Free).
