



FH Canada is part of the global Food for the Hungry network, a Christian non-profit organization dedicated to ending poverty in the most vulnerable communities through an integrated, holistic approach to sustainable development, including priorities such as agriculture, education, health, and gender equality.

Since 2005, Lambrick has partnered with FH Canada in the Sasiga lowlands, a region west of Addis Ababa in Ethiopia. At that time Sasiga had no child sponsorship, no base camp, no clean water, gardens or healthy cattle. There was little leadership in an undeveloped community of both Christian and Muslim groups.

Today LPC is celebrating 12 years of partnership and the graduation of Sasiga from FH Canada. 25,000 Sasiga lowlanders have recognizably alleviated poverty in their lives through our partnership, achieving sustainability in health, education, agriculture and social structure.
