

THIS SUNDAY: TOXIC FORGETFULNESS

Our speaker is Daniel McDougall, who ministers to international students at UVic. He says:

'We seem to have a fatal flaw in our common humanity: a toxic inability to simply remember important things...Sometimes the things that really need remembering elude our grasp, often with the result of having to learn important lessons over and over again.

This is where we encounter the children of Israel this morning. They have experienced a remarkable deliverance from slavery, they've seen God's power with their own eyes but how quickly they—and we—forget...'

FROM SLAVERY TO FREEDOM

Exodus is the gospel in the Old Testament - the story of an oppressed, oppressive and idolatrous world and a God who brings freedom. Though chronicling events from thousands of years ago, the story of the Exodus is as fresh and needed today as ever.
