PRAYER MATTERS

Today we pray for International Justice Mission (IJM) and our partnership with them in Kolkata India to end sex trafficking. IJM says,

"While India has strong laws against sex trafficking, historically, these laws have not been enforced. When we began work in India, slavery seemed hidden: Many people told us they didn't believe it still existed in the country, and those who were aware of it didn't have hope that anything could change. But the scales are starting to tip toward justice—and, every day, we are seeing proof that makes us more confident that slavery in India can end within our lifetime."

We pray for IJM staff and partners as they rescue victims, bring criminals to justice, strengthen justice systems, and partner with organizations such as Mahima Homes, to restore survivors. We also pray for those who are still in sexual slavery - that they may be liberated, and the survivors - that they may experience healing and restoration.
