

PRAYER MATTERS

Brent and Shelley Weeks are with Reach Beyond Radio Ministry in Australia. Shelley was extra busy in March implementing the audio programming for the shortwave radio schedule that commenced on the 31st of March. One ongoing challenge with the new schedule has been reintroducing a Hindi program from the Reach Beyond archives which requires shortening the programs (155 of them) and editing them without actually knowing Hindi!

Reach Beyond is working on a number of initiatives for Myanmar. One is to expand the distribution of shortwave radios in various parts of Myanmar with the help of our partners who have dozens of local people in their ministry network available to assist. Please pray for this initiative, so that more people can hear radio programs sharing the message of hope in Jesus.

Meanwhile, Brent, along with a number of our staff and volunteers, has continued to spend a lot of time towards finishing up the new donor management system, integrated with their new website.

Brent and Shelley will be visiting Victoria from June 5 to August 12. They will be giving Lambrick an update on their ministry in person on July 14, and say: "We would love to connect with family, friends and our faithful supporters while we are in Victoria!"
