PRAYER MATTERS

Today we pray for **Jessie-Anne Tromsness** who is in Cambodia doing a 4 month UVIC practicum with "The Moving Classroom".

Jessie Anne has been part of our Lambrick family during her time at UVIC – serving in the children's and music ministry as well as in Wiseways.

The Moving Classroom project is an alternative education solution for areas of extreme need where the proper infrastructure for schooling is not fully functional. They provide pop-up school classrooms and Sunday schools for students, with mobile classrooms on a mat or in existing spaces in a village. They also help improve existing education programs by creating teaching tools and training teachers.



Today we can pray for Jessie-Anne, and if desired, donate to the Moving Classrooms project. We can assist Jessie-Anne to reach her goal of raising \$3,000 to rent and renovate a tin hut and provide school supplies to create a better space for the children to learn.
